OUR COMMITMENT

PLEASE READ THIS CAREFULLY. Our paramount interest is to ensure that everything goes smoothly and that you enjoy your holiday fully from start to finish. Please read carefully the following Booking Conditions as your signature on the Booking Form confirms acceptance of them on behalf of all members of your party. For the purposes of this agreement, all the holidays in this brochure are operated by Crown Travel Limited trading as Le Boat (hereinafter called 'Le Boat', 'the Company'), the 'Hirer' is the person who signs the Booking Form' and/ or any member of his party and the 'Boat' is the boat which has been reserved or that which has been allocated to the hirer by the Company.

OUTDOOR TRAVEL'S RESPONSIBILITY: Outdoor Travel Pty Ltd, including the owners, officers and employees give notice that they act only as agents for the Company who arrange the services described in this brochure. Outdoor Travel Pty Ltd assumes no responsibility for any loss or damage to baggage or property or for any injury, illness or death or any claims arising directly or indirectly from the operation of these boat cruises or any delays, transport failures, strikes, war, force majeure, Acts of God etc that may affect any of these services or travel arrangements. All matters arising from the services Outdoor Travel Pty Ltd provide are governed by the law in the State of Victoria, Australia.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES: Active holidays can be hazardous if you behave foolishly so don't take risks! In the interests of safety, you undertake to follow the advise of the operator, guide or representative; comply with any local codes of conduct; and act sensibly and prudently at all times. You also agree to indemnify Outdoor Travel Pty Ltd its owners, officers and employees for all losses and / or damage arising from any act or default on your part or the part of a member of your party.

You also accept the responsibility to ensure your personal travel documents (ie full passport, driving licence, visas etc) are in order. Check with your travel agent or Outdoor Travel well before departure.

1 Booking: A boat is not booked and no contract shall exist until:

- The completed and signed Booking Form together with the non-refundable deposit of 40% of the total cost (or full payment if less than 100 days before departure) have been received by Outdoor Travel Pty Ltd.
- Confirmation has been issued by Outdoor Travel Pty Ltd.
- A Provisional Reservation can be held for 48 hours without payment before being automatically cancelled

2 Your Contract

Your contract is with Crown Travel Ltd trading as Le Boat. When making your booking you guarantee that you have the authority to do so and accept on behalf of your party the terms of these booking conditions. A contract exists, when you confirm your holiday booking with payment. On receipt of this payment we will send you a booking confirmation. You should check the details carefully to ensure that it accurately reflects the boat and additional pre-bookable services that you have requested and immediately inform us of any discrepancies.

3 Your Holiday Price

The prices in this separate price list are in Australian Dollars. Prices are accurate at the date of publication, but could have since changed. Prices in this price list supersede all other prices in other material printed at an earlier stage. Once you have made your booking, paid a 40% deposit per booking plus payment for any extras requested (travel insurance, boat damage waiver, one way fee, bike hire) the cost of your holiday will not normally be subject to any change. This does not apply to invoice errors or omissions. Once a booking has been made, offers and discounts cannot be applied retrospectively. The balance of the price of your holiday must be paid at least 100 days before your departure date. If the balance is not paid by the balance due date, we may cancel your booking and retain your deposit. Extras not booked & paid for at the time of early booking will be charged at the new season prices at the base. Certain payments, as indicated in the pricing information, may be taken locally at the destination base in equivalent currency.

4 Conditions of hire

Hirers must be over 18 years of age. The minimum number of people required to hire a boat is 2 adults. The number of passengers on board may not exceed the maximum amount of passengers the boat is licensed for. The hirer must conform to the rules of river navigation, and also to the instruction given by the company and the river authorities. The hirer shall restrict his cruising to those waters permitted by the company.

The hirer shall not cruise after nightfall, nor engage in towing, sub hiring or lending of the boat.

5 If you Change or Cancel your booking

If, after our booking confirmation invoice has been issued, you wish to change your travel arrangements in any way, for example your chosen departure date, boat or destination, we will do our utmost to make these changes, but it may not always be possible. If you or any member of your party is unable to proceed with the holiday, you can transfer the booking to a substitute person, providing they satisfy all the conditions applicable to the original booking and your request is received by us at least 21 days prior to departure. Any request for changes to be made must be in writing signed by the Lead Name or your travel agent. The price of your holiday may increase or decrease to reflect the changes requested by you. You will be asked to pay an administration charge of \$200 per booking amendment and any further cost we incur in making this alteration. Please check whether your holiday insurance will cover any changes or increased costs resulting from a change. Should you request a major alteration within 100 days of departure date (such as a change of date or area) or if you want to amend your holiday departure date to a date not within the current year then this will be treated as a cancellation and re-booking.

You or any member of your party may cancel your travel arrangements at any time. Written notification (by post or email) from the Lead Name or your travel agent on your behalf must be received by OUTDOOR TRAVEL Pty Ltd. Cancellation will be effective on the date which it is received by Crown Travel/Le Boat. Please note: If the reasons for your cancellation are covered under the terms of your insurance policy, you may be able to reclaim these charges – we encourage you to buy insurance when making a booking.

6 Cancellation - If we cancel or amend your holiday

The arrangements for holidays in this brochure are made many months in advance and it is sometimes inevitable that changes or cancellations may need to be made. We reserve the right to make such changes should they become necessary. Most of these changes will be minor and we will advise you of them at the earliest possible date. We also reserve the right in any circumstances to cancel your travel arrangements. Sometimes we may have to make a major change to your booking, this would include, but is not limited to, change of cruising area, change of departure date and change of boat to a lesser model. If we have to make a major change to your holiday (other than due to your default in payment) we will:

- Offer you an alternative holiday to the same or better standard (where available)
- Offer you a lesser holiday and a refund of the difference in price (where available); or
- Cancel your holiday and give you a full refund of all monies paid excluding any insurance premiums paid to us.

Force Majeure means unusual and unforeseeable circumstances beyond our control, the consequences of which could not have been avoided even if all due care had been exercised. Examples of Force Majeure are listed in the appropriate section of these conditions. We strongly recommend you provide us with an emergency contact telephone number in case of any unexpected changes that need to be made to your holiday at short notice.

7 Insurance

Crown Travel/Le Boat has comprehensively insured the boat. The policy covers damage or loss to the boat and also no less than Euro 7-million third-party liability. This policy extends to cover any incident caused by the Hirer or the Hirer's crew. This policy is included in the cost of your holiday. The policy in place has certain reasonable exclusions to cover as a result of certain actions by the Hirer or the Hirer's crew. These include willful damages or gross negligence, persons being under the influence of drugs or alcohol or as a result of not obeying the instructions of member of Crown Travel/Le Boat staff. If the insurer fails to indemnify Crown Travel/Le Boat because of the above then the Hirer is responsible for all costs. Adults will at all times be responsible for the minors in their care.

Crown Travel/Le Boat insurance does not cover the Hirer's personal belongings. We strongly recommend that you take out comprehensive travel insurance – please ask your travel agent or OUTDOOR TRAVEL Pty Ltd.

8 Prices

The prices quoted in the brochure and price list are based on costs, exchange rates, taxes and levies as known at the time of printing in 2009. The price of your travel arrangements may be subject to surcharges for increases in:

- i) Transportation costs e.g. fuel,
- ii) Dues, taxes or fees chargeable for services e.g. landing taxes:
- iii) International currency fluctuations.

9 Damage Waiver

Insurers charge Crown Travel/Le Boat an excess with every incident and also the cost of claims potentially forces up the premiums we pay. To encourage a duty of care from you, the Hirer, and to contribute to covering this costs we ask you to pay either:

Option 1: Non-refundable Collision Damage Waiver*

A charge of between \$132 - \$395, depending on the type of boat, can be made at the time of booking. With this option, you are fully covered if the boat or any of its equipment or inventory is returned damaged or lost, or if there is any incidental damage to third parties.

**In certain instances we may insist on a deposit rather than the waiver.*

Option 2: Refundable Damage Deposit

On arrival at the base, you will leave a refundable deposit of Euro 1,500 which will only be exercised if the boat or any of its equipment or inventory is returned damaged or lost or in the case of any accidental damage to third parties. Please note the damage waiver options do not cover any acts of gross negligence, such as damage occurred if cruising outside the instruction given by Le Boat or rules of river navigation, cruising under the influence of alcohol or drugs, running aground or cruising single handed as stated in the conditions of hire.

10 Fuel Deposit

Before departing the base on board your cruiser, you will be required to leave a fuel deposit. This deposit is towards the cost of the fuel charges as described on our Information Page.

11 Embarkation/Disembarkation and Cruising Route

Boat embarkation time is usually from 4.00pm on your start day and disembarkation must be by 9.00am on the return day. Priority boarding from midday can be requested. This will be detailed on your booking confirmation. A boat briefing and local cruising briefing will be conducted before you depart the base. The Company reserves the right to make changes to the times and/or direction of the cruise. Minor changes will not entitle the Hirer to cancel with a refund or compensation.

12 Navigational Restrictions

Our brochure offers a number of cruising suggestions for each region based on our experience and knowledge of the area. At the start of your cruise, you will receive a Waterways Guide and/or detailed cruising notes for your region, clearly stating which waterways are navigable and which are prohibited or restricted. The base team will also advise on any specific routes, which are prohibited or restricted, or procedures falling under the control of the National Inland Waterways Authorities. Our guarantee does not cover cruising in areas that are prohibited or restricted. Please contact the sales team prior to departure if you wish to cruise on any waterways not covered in our brochure.

13 Accidents and Loss of Equipment

If the boat is involved in an accident of any nature, the Hirer must immediately contact the base and complete an accident report form supplied and ask any other party involved to complete the same form. The hirer will not ask for any repairs to be carried out without Crown Travel/Le Boat prior agreement. Should any equipment be lost, stolen or broken, the Hirer must report this on return of the boat.

14 Bicycle Theft Waiver

You can insure your bicycle against theft for a charge of between Euro 6 per bike per week and Euro 10 per bike for two weeks. This can be booked and paid for on arrival at the start base. With this option you will be fully covered if the bicycle is stolen.

15 Technical Assistance

Crown Travel/Le Boat has a breakdown service during normal working hours every day of the week. We will endeavour to attend and repair a breakdown or technical incident as quickly as possible. The Hirer will have no claim against Crown Travel/Le Boat for any failure caused by the hirer including but not limited to grounding, and in such instances the company will reserve the right to recover from the Hirer the expenses incurred in rectifying the matter.

16 Return of the Boat

The boat must be returned by 9.00am on your final day at the correct base. Late returns will incur a fee of Euro 500. We expect the boat to be returned reasonably clean i.e. with all bedding stripped, all crockery and utensils cleaned and restored, floors swept, decks mopped and rubbish neatly bagged ready to go ashore. If the boat is left in an unsatisfactory condition, a cleaning fee of between Euro 75 and Euro 95 will apply dependent on the type of boat. (Refer to our pricing information for our cleaning service price).

17 Fuel Charges

In France, Belgium, Holland Italy and Germany, Crown Travel/Le Boat charges the amount of hours the engine has been running. At the start of your cruise you will be informed of how much the per-hour charge will be and the current engine hours on your boat will be agreed and recorded with you. In Ireland, England and Scotland, Crown Travel/Le Boat charges fuel by the litre. At the start of your cruise the boat will be handed to you with a full tank of fuel and you will be informed by the staff member how much your fuel will cost per litre.

18 Your Security - Limitations on our liability

Crown Travel / Le Boat's liability to you for any loss or damage which you may suffer is limited to three times the price of your holiday. This excludes personal injury resulting from the non-performance or improper performance of the services involved in the holiday, and is subject to the limitation of liability described below. Health and safety standards applicable to the services provided by us under this contract should meet the local standards applicable to your holiday destination.

19 Hirer's Suitability

The Hirers must accept responsibility for the proper conduct of him/herself and any members of their party. Crown Travel/Le Boat cannot be held responsible for under age consumption of alcohol. We reserve the right to terminate without further notice the holiday arrangements of any client who refuses to comply with the instructions or orders of the company staff, its agent or other responsible person and whose behaviour in their opinion is likely to cause distress, damage or danger or annoyance to other customers, staff, any third party or to property. Upon such termination our responsibility for your holiday ceases and we shall not be liable for any extra costs incurred by you.

20 Boat Descriptions: Boat layout plans; specifications and illustrations in the brochure are general guidance. Some models within boat classes have minor variations.

21 Force Majeure

We regret we cannot accept responsibility for or pay any compensation where performance or prompt performance of our contact with you is prevented or affected by reason of circumstances amounting to 'Force Majeure'. Such circumstances include without restriction: the destruction or damage of your boat through fire, flood, explosion, storm or weather damage; accidental damage; criminal damage or any other force outside of our control. These also include flooding, shortage of water, obstruction, repairs to any waterway, lock or navigational equipment, shortage of or non-availability of fuel, riots or civil strife, industrial action or nuclear disaster, fire, adverse weather conditions, port blockades, war or threat of war, and actual or threatened terrorist activity or similar.

22 Complaints: If you have a complaint whilst you are on holiday, please inform the base manager or a Crown Travel/Le Boat office immediately so that remedial actions can be taken. If you wish to make a claim against us then you must notify us in writing within 28 days of your return home by writing to the Customer Relations Department at Le Boat, The Port House, Port Solent, Portsmouth, PO6 4TH, United Kingdom.

Disputes that cannot be amicably settled may (if you wish) be referred to the arbitration under a special scheme which, although devised by arrangement with the Association of British Travel Agents (ABTA), is administered quite independently by the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators. Contact ABTA for details and application forms. The arbitrator will only deal with your complaint if it relates to your holiday and:

- * you are claiming £5000 for each person or £25000 for each booking (or Australian \$ equivalent).
- * you contact ABTA within 9 months of the end of your tour, and
- * your complaint does not involve major physical injury or illness in excess of £5000 (or Australian \$ equivalent).

23 Law & Jurisdiction: This agreement, and any claim or dispute arising from or related to this agreement, will be governed by Australian law and the courts shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any claim arising out of it.
