



CYCLING IN CANADA

PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND - CYCLING HOLIDAYS ON THE EAST COAST



This summer head north to Canada to explore the wild coastline and fishing villages of Prince Edward Island on an 8-day / 7-night self-guided inn-to-inn cycling holiday.

Begin in Charlottetown with a short test ride through the residential and historic sections of the Island's capital. Typically, you'll head to southeastern Prince Edward Island for two nights at a bed & breakfast with a fiddle maker as your host. Then cycle the beautiful, quiet and flat coast past small fishing villages and Prince Edward Island's only winery.

Stay two nights in Montague overlooking the river and marina, visiting one of Prince Edward Island's most picturesque destinations, Panmure Island. An optional seal watching boat tour is highly recommended. Then, cycle inland to St Peter's and the wonderful dune system at Greenwich National Park. During your two nights stay in St Peter's you'll ride Prince Edward Island's beautiful north shore before returning to Charlottetown via the best of the Confederation Trail.

Day 1: Arrival, outfitting at our pro shop, test ride through the residential, waterfront and historic sections of our Charlottetown. Free evening for optional theatre, shopping or sight seeing. Accommodations in a heritage inn near the heart of the city.

Day 2: Departure this morning through seaside communities and rolling countryside to southeast PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND. Comfortable accommodation for 2 nights in a typical B&B (the owner is a renowned maker of fine stringed instruments). Luggage transfer. **30miles/50km – B**

Day 3: Cycle to Cape Bear's red sand stone cliffs visiting Wood Islands, Wood Islands & Northumberland Provincial Parks. Visit Rossignol Estate Winery & the Marconi lighthouses, the fishing port of Murray Harbour and the Murray River village before returning to your B&B. **47mi/75km – B**

Day 4: Head inland, taking in the brilliant greens and reds of rich farmland as you make your way to the riverside town of Montague. Your Inn overlooks the Montague Marina, as does our recommended evening's dining. Luggage transfer. **22mi/36km - B**

Optional afternoon seal watching boat cruise.

Day 5: Visit the beautiful white sand beach of Panmure Island and the picturesque lighthouse and causeway. Double back for your return ride to Montague. **25mi/41km – B**

Day 6: Cycle to St Peters for accommodation on St Peters Bay continuing to Greenwich National Park to explore the unique and wonderful sand dune system. Luggage transfer. (23mi/37km to St Peters). **34mi/55km – B**

Optional (11mi/18km) round trip to Greenwich National Park.

Day 7: Cycle along the north shore stopping at Naufrage and turning south at Clear Springs to connect with the Confederation Trail before returning to St Peters. **38mi/64km – B**

Day 8: Return cycle to Charlottetown via a paved highway and/or Confederation Trail. View cultured mussel farming along the way. Luggage transfer. **33mi/54km - B**

Cost Includes: Bicycle rental & outfitting (bikes equipped with rear carrier & bungee cord, souvenir water bottle & cage, helmet and a lock). 7 nights of accommodation in Island inns and bed & breakfasts (rooms are equipped with private bath. All breakfasts. Luggage transfers. Detailed route cards & highlighted maps, emergency road repair service & all taxes. Our bikes are the 24-speed Mikado Hampstead a classic comfort bike with a suspension seat post to reduce shock and eliminate vibration on trails or imperfect roads. The height adjustable handlebar post allows you optimum comfort and flexibility.
