Includes: Twin-berth air-conditioned cabins with private bathroom facilities, ship's crew; captain, cook and multi-lingual cycle guide, breakfast and picnic lunch each day, three-course dinner on six nights; coffee and tea every day after cycling; bed linen and (on request) clean towels every day; daily cleaning service; bike hire (24-gear hybrid bicycle - frame size: 44 / 49 / 53 / 57cm); water bottle and pannier; harbour dues and tourist tax; ferry fares on the route.

Not included: Transfer to and from the boat in Amsterdam or Bruges; admission fees to attractions; dinner on Saturday night; drinks or personal expenses. Helmets can be hired or you may prefer to bring or buy your own

Suggested itinerary (subject to change – itineraries are also offered in reverse)

Sunday - Arrive Bruges

Cycling distance @ 10 to 15 km

The crew will welcome you aboard with a cup of coffee or tea at 2.00pm. Then there is an introduction to the crew, an explanation of the rules on board and information on the program for the week ahead. After the introduction there is a short cycling tour to Damme, a small historical town close to Bruges. This is an opportunity to get comfortable with your bike and make the necessary adjustments. In the evening after dinner your guide will take you for a walk through the wonderful streets of Bruges.

Monday - Bruges – Gent

Cycling distance @ 52 km

Green pastures and picturesque little towns as you cycle to Gent. Gent also called the *pride of Belgium*, a university town with a great atmosphere and lots to see!

Tuesday Gent – Middelburg

Cycling distance @ 55 km

Today's program offers a tour from Belgium Vlaanderen into Dutch Vlaanderen. At first we will begin with a 2 to 3-hour cruise from Gent to Sas van Gent, on the Belgium-Dutch border. Then we start cycling until we cross the Westerschelde by ferry. The change of culture as we pass from one country to the next becomes very noticeable as we travel deeper into the Dutch countryside of the province of Zeeland. New Zealand was named after this province by the Dutch seaman Abel Tasman. We rejoin the boat and spend the night in Middelburg.

Wednesday Middelburg – Zierikzee

Cycling distance @ 52 km

Today you will encounter one of the wonders of the world as, by bicycle you cross the great dam that was built after the great flood of Zeeland in 1953. This is still the Dutch answer to taming the seas. Before crossing the dam we visit Veere, a small town with a considerable history.

We spend the night in Zierikzee right in the heart of Zeeland. Your guide will give a short tour around this beautiful town.

Thursday Zierikzee – Willemstad – Dordrecht

Cycling distance @ 54 km

From Zierikzee we cycle to Willemstad over the Volkerak locks, also part of the plan to protect Holland against the sea. Willemstad was named after a Dutch king. Historically this fortified town has played an important role in the Dutch military defence system for hundreds of years. We will spend the night here.

Friday Dordrecht – Vianen

Cycling distance @ 48 km

After a 2 – 3-hour cruise we begin cycling in the town of Dordrecht. After a short visit to the centre of this town we move on to Kinderdijk, one of the most famous attractions of Holland. Here we will find the largest collection of windmills together in a park as they were originally built.

Cycling along the meandering River Lek we stop at Schoonhoven, again an old town well known for its Silversmiths. There is time for you to go shopping and to explore the many Silver shops. From Schoonhoven we continue to Vianen where we will spend the night.

Saturday Vianen – Breukelen – Amsterdam

Cycling distance @ 30 km

Again we start the day with a 2-hour boat cruise this time to Breukelen. From here we cycle along the lovely River Vecht through the Diemer Forest to Amsterdam where our barge will be waiting for you. In the afternoon we have the opportunity to do some shopping in Amsterdam and in the evening you are free to find a restaurant for dinner.

Overnight in Amsterdam – free time - your guide can tell you about the many attractions to be seen here.

Sunday Amsterdam

The tour ends after breakfast when you disembark at 9.00am.
