Wednesday - Depart for Giglio Island with time to swim & have lunch in one of the bays. Dinner on board.

Thursday - Set-sail for the island of Giannutri, lunch on the way. Afternoon visit to the site of a roman villa.

Friday – Visit Saturnia Hot Springs or the beaches of Feniglia. Lunch in a typical Tuscan restaurant & dinner on board.

Saturday - Return to Talamone, breakfast and cruise ends at 10.00am.
