About the Fleurieu Peninsula

This tour explores the beautiful Fleurieu Peninsula. Named by the French explorer Nicholas Baudin this Peninsula is steeped in history and covered in beauty.

The Fleurieu Peninsula is bounded to the west by the Gulf St Vincent, and the Southern Ocean to the Southeast. In between are beautiful ranges, deep valleys, picturesque towns and rolling meadows.

We encounter abundant flora and fauna along the way as we follow sections of the Heysen Trail, South Australia's long distance walking trail. We carry only daypacks. Your luggage is transferred while you walk.

Sample Itinerary

Day 1

After packing your gear on board we travel to Myponga Beach, where we will begin our walk. We leave the coast behind us as we follow steep back roads for five kilometres. After crossing the Myponga Reservoir we join the Heysen Trail, which we follow through the Myponga Conservation Park.

Walking Distance: 17km

Day 2

After a hearty breakfast we walk through the Second Valley forest reserve, climb to the summit of Sheoak Hill and stroll through rolling farmland.

Walking Distance: 17km

Day 3

Today we continue our walk south east leaving the Heysen Trail and joining quiet back roads to finish at Encounter Bay where Captain Matthew Flinders and Captain Nicholas Baudin had a chance meeting over 200 years ago.

Enjoy a coffee and afternoon tea in Victor Harbour on your way back to Adelaide. Arriving back at approx. 6:00pm.

Walking Distance: 18km

- All entry and permit fees.
