GREECE - IONIAN ISLANDS FROM CORFU TO CEPHALONIA

8-days / 7-nights Moderate to challenging PREMIUM GUIDED cycling & sailing between scenic islands







The Ionian Islands are to the west of the Greece mainland. It is a place of sparkling colours: the silvery green of olive groves, deep blue skies and the clear azure blue Ionian Sea. Starting from the popular island of Corfu, our journey takes us off the beaten track to discover Ithaca, known locally as the 'diamond of the Ionians', to see the abundant bird life of Lefkas, the rugged mountains of Cephalonia and the beautiful olive groves of Paxos. Relax, enjoy the beauty and delicious Greek cuisine in the local restaurants and onboard our traditional motor yacht.

Bike and Boat cycling cruises combine two popular ways of exploring (cycling and island hopping) allowing partners of different abilities and interests to holiday together (trips are just as interesting for leisure cyclists OR enthusiasts). Unpack once and come 'home' each night to a wonderful meal and a comfortable cabin with your own bathroom. On any day if you prefer you can choose to skip the cycling and spend time cruising instead.

Cycling routes vary, on average 25km to 50km, undulating with some hilly sections (elevations between 300m and 700m), with some extended uphill stretches. Most roads are sealed.

Cruise includes: 7 nights on a motor yacht with crew, in double / twin or single cabins with ensuite; 2 days full board on the ship (breakfast, lunch and dinner), 5 days of half-board (breakfast and either lunch or dinner); English speaking tour guide and guided cycling tours; hire of hybrid bicycle with pannier; group entry to museums and archaeological sites.

Not included in tour: Personal expenses, gratuities, local fees, port taxes (paid to captain), drinks (tally sheet onboard to be paid at end of trip), meals taken onshore on half-board days, transfers to/from the ship (group transfer from Corfu airport on arrival or departure date can be booked at extra cost - please ask for details), Helmet use is mandatory on all bike tours – some bike helmets are available onboard but we recommend you bring your own or purchase one for this trip.

We offer this as a Bike and Boat cycling tour; however, you can decide each day if you want to cycle as part of the group with the guide, cycle independently or not ride and relax onboard the boat. Non-cyclists are always welcome on these departures but please note there are no alternative sightseeing provisions made on cycling days. The tour requires a minimum number of passengers to operate.

Suggested itinerary: subject to weather and sailing conditions

Day 1 (Friday) Arrive in Corfu

Plan to arrive at the boat from 2.00pm onwards. Dinner is on board and overnight mooring in the port of Corfu.

Day 2 (Saturday) Corfu Island - Sivota - Parga - Lefkas Island

cycling @ 30km

After breakfast we sail to Sivota and then ride to Parga, the main tourist town on the west coast of the mainland. A highlight is the medieval fort above the old town. We rejoin the yacht and head to Nidri on Lefkas Island.

Day 3 (Sunday) Island of Lefkas

cycling @ 35km

After breakfast we cycle to waterfalls just outside Nidri, where we may get in a swim, then continue along peaceful roads through the mountains via Siyros to the picturesque harbor town of Sivota. From there we head to our overnight stop at Fiskardo on the northern tip of Cephalonia. Visitors are charmed by Fiskardo's historic buildings, traditional fishing boats, and the cafes, bars and restaurants on the harbour promenade.

Day 4 (Monday) Cephalonia Island

cycling @ 40km

We cycle today from Fiskardo to Sami, along the impressive mountain pass on the eastern coast of Cephalonia. We can stop for photographs, especially the panoramic view to neighbouring Ithaca. En route to Sami we can stop for an optional visit to the stalactite and stalagmite caves of Melissani, which can only be viewed in row boats. After our cycle tour we cruise to Vathy on Ithaca.

Day 5 (Tuesday) Islands of Ithaca – Meganisi

cycling @ 20km or 30km

Picturesque Ithaca, the home of the mythical king Odysseus, is an island where time seems to stand still. On our cycle route we can enjoy the gnarled olive trees, crystal clear water and friendly islanders of Ithaca. From Frikes the boat takes us to the island of Meganisi (passing the private island of shipping magnate Aristoteles Onassis).

Day 6 (Wednesday) Island of Meganisi - Paxos

cycling @ 20km

In the morning we explore the island of Meganisi, cycling along quiet island roads and through the three villages of the island, giving us a good impression of the traditional life of the Greeks. In the afternoon we sail to Paxos, where we have the option to spend the evening in a cozy taverna in Gaios.

Day 7 (Thursday) Islands of Paxos and Corfu

cycling @ 25km

The beautiful olive groves of Paxos, the smallest of the seven Ionian Islands, give the island its wonderful silvery green colour. Our ride takes us around the island, stopping to have a swim in the Mediterranean at one of the many beaches. After lunch we cruise back to Corfu town, and enjoy dinner on board, a festive final get-together in a cosy atmosphere with crew and tour guides.

Day 8 (Friday) Corfu town

Tour ends after breakfast with optional transfers to the airport, or ask about extending your stay in Greece.
