**Trip Grading:** Walk moderate or longer distances. Sections of hilly or upland areas and may have sections of rough or steeper terrain and will require reasonable fitness. Choice of easier walks of 7-12km on mostly good paths with ascents up to 600m or harder walks of 14-16km with some steeper and rougher ascents up to 1000m ascent in a day.

A typical European centre-based walking holiday offers a choice of up to two guided walks each day. You choose the walk that best suits your ability and fitness. Walks leaders make the final decision on which routes are offered; each evening they will brief you about the walks for the next day and answer questions you may have.

#### Suggested itinerary (Routes are determined by the walk leaders each day and are subject to change):

#### Day 1: Arrival day

Plan to arrive in Spello before dinner.

#### **Day 2: Aqueduct Ring Walk**

Wander past the impressive Porta Montanara and follow the course of an ancient viaduct to climb above Spello into the olive groves for views of Monte Subasio and Vale of Spoleto.

#### Day 3: Spello to Assissi

Walk the trail along Monte Subasio, passing behind Villa Fidelia built by Mussolini. Continue past vineyards and olive groves to the picture-postcard town of Assisi, where we explore the medieval town and tour the Basilica of St Francis. The harder walk climbs the foothills of Monte Subasio, taking in spectacular views over the Vale of Spoleto, to the Hermitage of St Francis.

#### Day 4: Free day

Spend the day enjoying the medieval streets of Spello and visiting the church of Santa Maria Maggiore with its frescoes painted by Pinturicchio, Umbria's most famous artist. Or head to the region's capital Perugia for hilltop views, a subterranean Etruscan temple, and Piazza V Novembre with its gothic cathedral and impressive fountain.

#### Day 5: Wine Country

We head to the opposite side of the Vale of Spoleto to the walled medieval town of Bevagna then through the vineyards to Montefalco, the capital of Umbrian wine – most famous for its Sagrantino red wine.

#### Day 6: Assisi

Follow the ancient rocky path up to Assisi and through tranquil woods where you can visit the Hermitage of St Francis. Or choose the walk that climbs to the summit of Monte Subasio, known as the holy mountain, taking in beautiful spring flowers, ancient towns, forests, and meadows.

#### Day 7: Spoleto, Viaducts and Ancient Railways

Viaducts and Ancient Railways Head to Roman Spoleto, with its grand viaduct and Roman amphitheatre, crossing the Bridge of Towers, climbing through forested trails to Monteluco. Or follow the old railway line running between Spoleto and Norcia. Enjoy wine tasting in a local enoteca for our farewell dinner.

#### Day 8: Departure day

Tour ends after breakfast. Join the group coach transfer to Rome airport or depart Spello by train.
